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Education

Note: This policy was published in last month's Newsletter. It was taken from an image. It was decided it was necessary to publish again as text.

From the desk of Dick Card, Education Director:

Since PWCC has many new faces, I think this is a good time to once again mention the differences between PWCC SEMINARS AND PWCC IN HOUSE CLASSES.

PWCC SEMINARS are taught by Pros either from our club or other clubs in the U. S. or Canada. The person teaching the class charges according to their own policy. PWCC collects the money for their fees and hands the money to them after class is over. Carvers who attend the seminars do not have to be PWCC members but they must abide by the rules on the registration forms.

Forms and checks must reach the Education Director or their mailbox by certain dates given in the ads. There are usually a minimum number of students for a class to continue. So the seminar teacher has to be contacted in time for them to change their schedule if we don't have a minimum number. Occasionally, the educator will accept the number we have enrolled if it is close to their minimum. This is unusual, though. When we cannot reach their minimum we have to cancel the class. At that time, we notify those registered and return the monies collected.

REGISTRATION FORMS are on the PWCC website.

As for the **IN-HOUSE CLASSES, THESE ARE FOR MEMBERS ONLY and member yearly dues must be paid for a member to sign up to attend.** There is a minimal charge for wood and material. These classes are taught by our member carvers and some of them are also pros.

To take an In-House class, there are no forms involved. **You MUST CONTACT The Education Director** via email or home phone or at a Carve-In.

If you sign up and can not make the class, please be courteous enough to let the Education Director know so your spot can be offered to the next person in line if the class is over maximum.

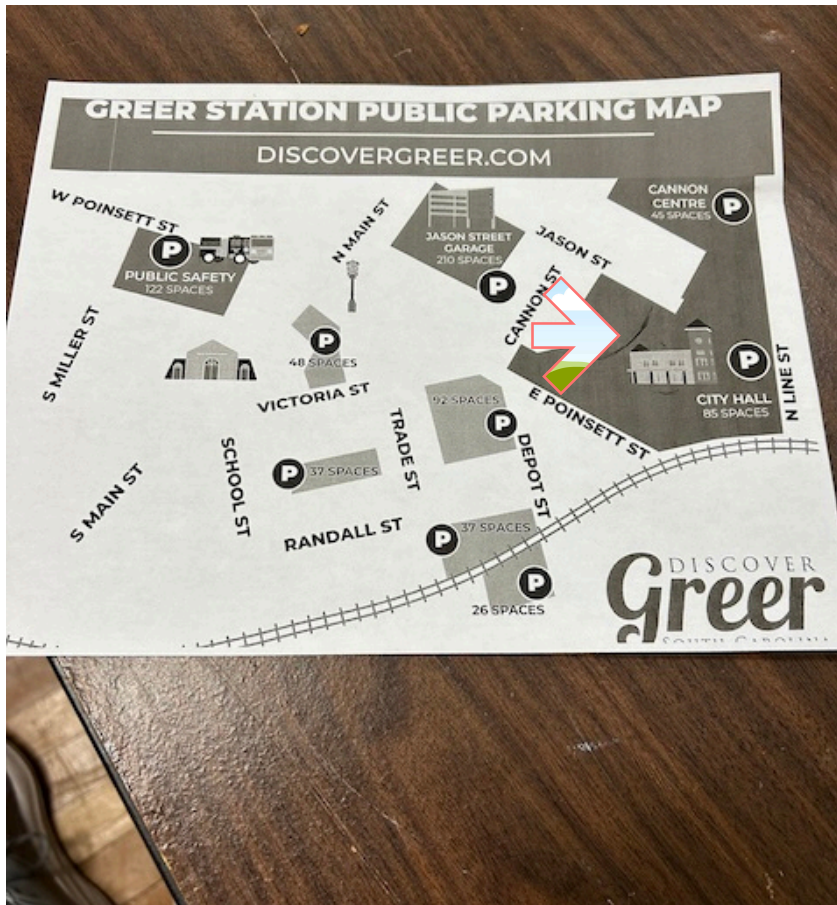
Note the date of the November Member Meeting , November 19th to accomodate the Thanksgiving Holiday.

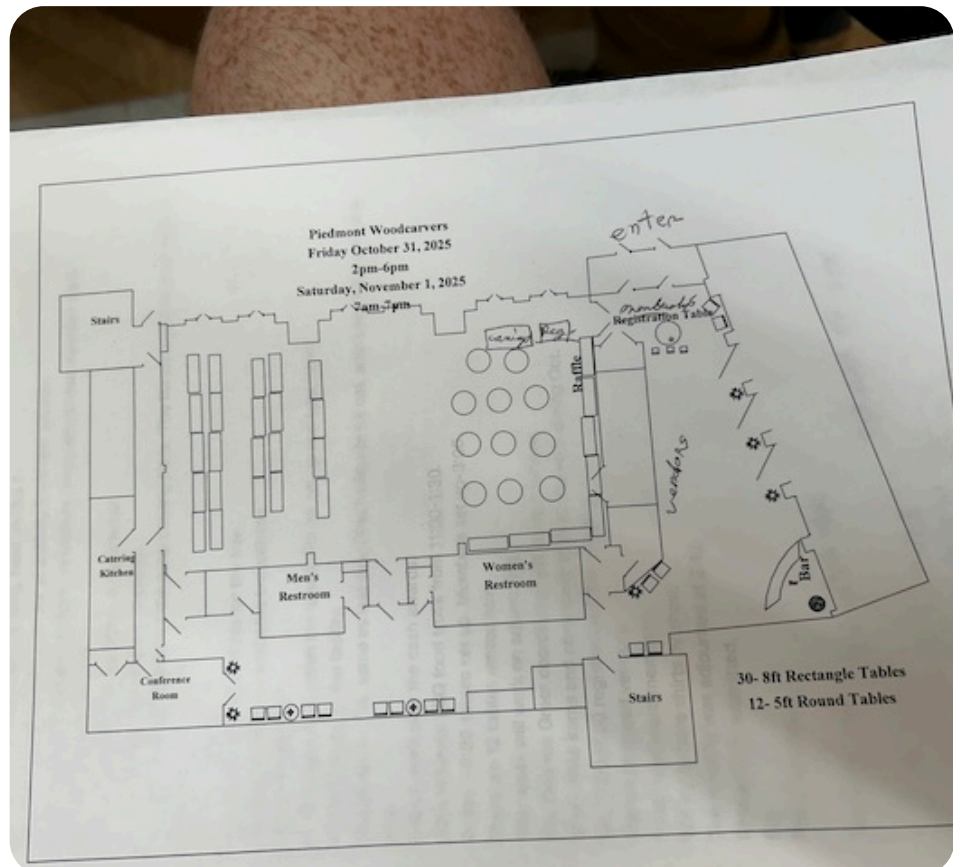
